

Money Words Pelmanism Warmer

Teacher's Notes

- Put these items below on a flat surface in front of the class.

a 50 pence coin

a ten-pound note

a credit card

a cheque book

a receipt

a utility bill

a postcard

a bank statement

a birthday card

a pay slip

a purse

a passport

a wallet

a driving licence

- The students have 1 minute to memorize the fourteen items. Teach any unknown vocabulary from the list of items.
- Cover the items with a cloth and challenge the students to write down as many of them as they can remember.
- Ask the students these questions and tell them they will need to use the words from the activity to answer them.

- What do you need to open a bank account?
- Where do you keep your notes and credit cards?
- What do you get in a shop when you pay for something?
- Where can you keep coins?
- What do you get from your employer at the end of the week or month?
- What does your bank send you to tell you about your account?
- What do you have to pay for the gas, electricity or telephone?
- Where can you see a picture of the Queen?
