The Great White Shark

The Great White Shark is the world's biggest predatory fish. It can be 20 feet long and weigh more than 4,000 pounds. Sharks live in cold or temperate waters, especially off the southern coast of Australia, in South Africa, and California.

They are gray, with a white stomach. Their teeth are very sharp and very sensitive. Sharks can smell, see, and hear very well, and can detect the electromagnetic field of a living animal.

They eat fish, small sharks, dolphins, and seals. They always hunt in the morning. They swim very fast and jump out of the water when they attack. They don't attack humans often, except in movies!

Sharks reproduce by laying eggs. The young sharks quickly grow to six and a half feet in the first year. Great white sharks can live for more than forty years.
