Languages

The first language used by early people was probably made up mostly of hand gestures and grunting sounds. Today, there are thousands of different languages spoken in the world. People usually give further meaning to their words by moving their hands or changing the expressions on their faces. Some languages have unusual features: The people of Gomera in the Canary Islands still use loud whistles to "speak" to one another across valleys. The language of the Khoisan people of southern Africa contains clicks made with the lips and tongue.

Most languages can be written down, using letters or symbols to represent sounds or words. Early writing was in the form of pictures. Today, most languages use an alphabet, although Chinese and Japanese still use symbols called characters.

More people speak Chinese than any other language. English would be the most common language if all the people who have learned to speak it were included. Spanish is spoken not only in Spain but also in much of Central and South America, where many Spanish people went to live hundreds of years ago.
