Keeping yourself safe on the Internet

E-mail

Never use e-mail to give important information such as passwords. Never open files or documents unless you know the person who has sent it. Finally, beware of "spam"—unwanted advertisements. If you have already downloaded "spam blocker" software, you will get less spam.

Chat Rooms

To keep safe, always use a nickname; never use your real name. Never give any personal information like your address, phone number, family details, or even your e-mail address. Never send photos of yourself or where you live. If someone has made you feel uncomfortable, sign off and tell your parents about it.

When you are logged on, make sure you have a comfortable chair and get up and move around often. However, you shouldn't spend too much time on the Internet. Every day, make sure you have also gotten out, exercised, played in the fresh air with your friends, and spent time with your family.
