An unlucky man

John Lyne has been run-over, struck by lightning twice, had three car crashes, nearly drowned and suffered numerous broken bones. John's bad luck began when he was born with underdeveloped lungs. Since then, his life has been a series of disasters.

As a child he drank a bottle of disinfectant and needed to have his stomach pumped. A year later he was riding on a cart and fell onto the road, where a van ran over him.

At the age of 14 he was struck by lightning while riding home on his bike and later nearly drowned in the sea. On a Friday the 13th, he fell from a tree, breaking his arm. His mother took him to the hospital, but he was sent home and asked to come back the next day. On the return, the bus crashed and he broke a second bone in his arm!

As an adult, John — who was a miner — nearly lost his life twice from falling rocks. He was also knocked over by a bus when he was waiting on the side of the road. What's more, while decorating his house, he touched a live electrical wire!

John's latest accident, in which he fell through an open hole at work, has put him out of action for more than 32 weeks. He hurt his back, left leg, and knees. Unfortunately, he is not sure if he will ever be able to go back to work.
