Facebook

The website www.facebook.com was created in 2004 by Mark Zuckerberg, a former Harvard University student. Anyone with a university e-mail address — from anywhere in the world — was allowed to join. Then in 2006, the website created networks for high school students. Since then, anyone 13 or older may join Facebook.

A new user signs on by choosing a name, a password, and a social group to join. That person can then create a personal web page, which usually includes photos. Members visit these web pages, and join groups of Facebook “friends,” so they can share information about recent activities and personal interests. Each member can log on each day to keep in touch with their new friends.
