

Extra Reading Comprehension Activities

For the Teacher

The Extra Reading Comprehension Activities are intended to supplement the activities that follow each reading in the Student's Book. They consist of two sets of activities: (1) basic comprehension questions and (2) critical thinking questions.

You may choose to use these reading activities in several ways: they can be used right after reading the article, right after doing the reading activities in the Student's Book, or as an alternative to the reading activities in the Student's Book. You may choose to only use the basic comprehension questions or the critical thinking questions. The activities can be completed with either verbal or written answers, and students can be asked to give either full or short answers. They can be assigned to be completed in or out of class.
