Preview the vocabulary with your students.

cheddar: *a firm smooth yellow or orange cheese*

croissant: *a soft bread roll shaped in a curve*

feta: *a crumbly white, tangy cheese, typical of Greece and the Balkans*

half and half: *a mixture of milk and cream, used in coffee*

whole-wheat: *whole-wheat flour or bread is made using every part of the wheat grain, including the outer layer*

Previewing (Answers may vary—as long as they are appropriate guesses, accept them for now.)

1. They are a customer and a waitress.
2. They are at a restaurant.
3. He is ordering breakfast and she is taking his order.
4. It's about a man who is on a diet but who is ordering a very fattening breakfast.

Video Script

Waitress: Here you go.

George: Uh, do you have any cream?

Waitress: There's milk there in the pitcher.

George: Yes. That's milk. Do you have any cream?

Waitress: Sorry. No cream. Half-and-half or milk.

George: Well then, half-and-half, please.

Waitress: Here you go.

George: Thanks.

Waitress: Are you ready to order?

George: I have a few questions.

George: The Think-Thin omelet . . . can I get that with cheddar cheese instead of feta cheese?

Waitress: Think-Thin with cheddar . . . no feta.

George: And can I get tomatoes instead of green peppers?

George: And instead of fruit, could I have potatoes?

Waitress: Think-Thin with cheddar, no feta, tomato, no green pepper, and potatoes, no fruit.

George: Oh! And can I get a croissant instead of the whole-wheat toast?

Waitress: Croissant . . . Sir, why don't you order the Omelet Supreme? It comes with cheddar, tomato, potatoes, and croissant.
