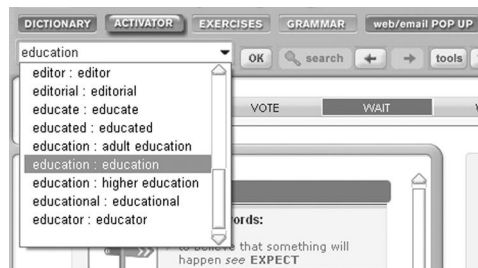
Procedure:

WORD CHOICE:
teacher, professor, lecturer, tutor, instructor, coach, trainer
A **teacher** usually works in a school.
• Do the children like their new teacher?
A **professor** is a teacher of the highest rank in a British university, and is a general term for a teacher in an American college.
