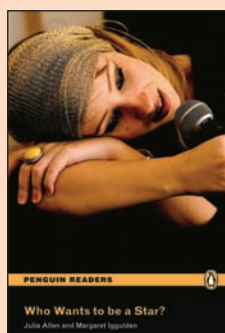

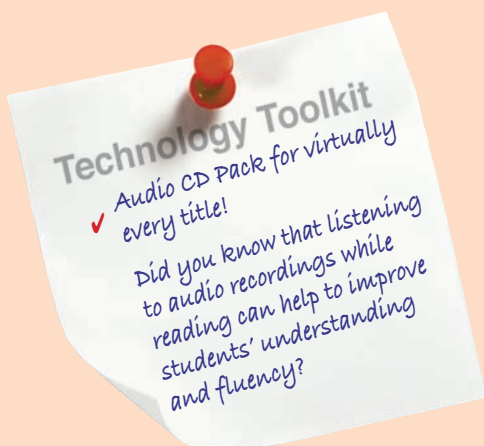

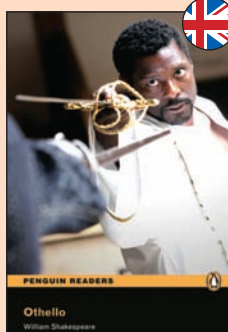
Level 2

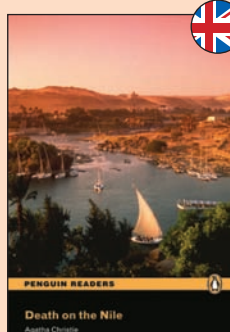
Level 4

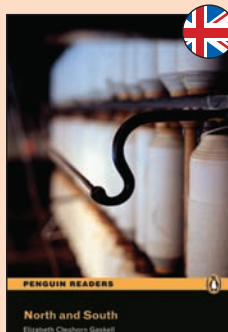
Level 4
