GENERAL LINGUISTIC RANGE	Has enough language to get by, with sufficient vocabulary to express him/herself with some hesitation and circumlocutions on topics such as family, hobbies and interests, work, travel,	129

VOCABULARY RANGE	Has a sufficient vocabulary to express him/herself with some circumlocutions on most topics pertinent to his/her everyday life such as family, hobbies and interests, work, travel, and current events.	124, 129
GRAMMATICAL ACCURACY	Communicates with reasonable accuracy in familiar contexts; generally good control though with noticeable mother tongue influence. Errors occur, but it is clear what he/she is trying to express.	126, 127
PHONOLOGICAL CONTROL	Pronunciation is clearly intelligible even if a foreign accent is sometimes evident and occasional mispronunciations occur.	125, 130
SOCIOLINGUISTIC APPROPRIATENESS	Is aware of the salient politeness conventions and acts appropriately.	130
