TEACHER'S NOTES:

Module 1 All about you

Aim: For students to find information in English on the Internet about the way of life in Britain. This webquest can be used at any point during the module.

Time: Approximately 45 minutes.

Materials: Photocopies of the worksheet for each student.

- 1 Tell students they are going to find out more information about the way of life in Britain. Check that they are on the correct page and that they have found the **Main Pages** box and have clicked on **British Way of Life**.
- 2 Tell students they are going to find out what a typical day is like for Craig, a child in England. Students click on **British Family Life** and then on **What is a typical day like for a child in Britain?** Students scroll down through Craig's day to find the answers to the questions.
 - a What time does the day start for Craig's family? **About 7 o'clock**
 - b What does Craig have for breakfast? **Rice Krispies, jam on toast and a glass of milk**
 - c What time does his mum pick him up from school? **3:15**
 - d What does Craig do with his family on Saturdays? **They go to the open market.**
- 3 Students go back to the previous page and click on **What do British people do during their leisure time?** to find out more about leisure activities in Britain and scroll down the page to find the answers to the questions:
 - a How many hours television do people in the UK watch a week? **25 hours per person**
 - b How much did British people spend on food outside the home in 1999? **£5.63**
- 4 Tell students that they are now going to find information about shopping in Britain. Students scroll down to **Activities outside the home** and click on **Shopping**. Students find the names of two department stores and two supermarkets.
- 5 To find information about sports played in Britain students go back to the **British Way of Life** page and click on **What sports do you play in England?** and take notes about two sports. Students can then share the information about these sports with their partners.
- 6 Students can then discuss with their partners how life in Britain is different to life in their countries.
- 7 If students have time they could browse the rest of the site for other interesting information about Britain.
