1) Read Sarah White's letter and look at her family.

Reading the letter and comparing it with the family chart will help students to understand the relationships.

2) Look at Sarah's family. Underline the correct words to complete the sentences.

- e) Carol White is Martin White's | wife | sister | mother |.
- f) Frank White is Martin White's | father | grandfather | husband |.
- g) Frank White is Carol White's | grandfather | father | mother |.
- h) Tina White is Sarah White's | grandmother | mother | brother |.
- i) Tom Green is Tina White's | husband | brother | father |.
- j) Susan White is Frank White's | sister | aunt | grandmother |.

3) Look at Sarah's family. Mark these statements TRUE or FALSE.

This exercise recycles key family vocabulary (including aunt and uncle) and relates this to the information about where people live.

- a) Sarah's aunt is called Carol. [TRUE]
- b) Frank White's sister lives in Oxford. [TRUE]
- c) Frank White has got a brother called Colin. [TRUE]
- d) Frank White is the father of Katie White. [FALSE]

- g) Tina White's son and daughter live in Brighton. [TRUE]
- h) Susan White has got a brother called Tom. [FALSE]
- i) Carol White's parents live in Brighton. [FALSE]
- j) Martin's aunt lives in Oxford. [TRUE]
