### Places quiz

#### TEACHER'S NOTES:

**Aim:** to practise and consolidate key vocabulary; places. This warmer is designed to be used in conjunction with unit 5.

**Time:** 40 minutes

**Materials:** copy of the worksheet for each student

- 1 Students work on their own or with a partner to write down where the cities are located. Students then write a short sentence about each city; you may want to do the first one as an example with the class. Monitor as they write to check if anyone needs help. Elicit answers from class.

**Answers:** a) London is in the south of England; b) Nice is in the south of France; c) Madrid is in the centre of Spain; d) Milan is in the north of Italy; e) Moscow is in the west of Russia; f) Dublin is in the east of Ireland; g) Melbourne is in the south of Australia; h) Los Angeles is in the west of the US

- 2 Students find the ten nationalities in the grid.
