- 1 You are going to go on the internet to find out information about two hotels in Brighton. Type in the website www.newsteinehotels.com. Click on the website link of the **Marine View Hotel** on the right side of the homepage and answer the following questions:
 - 1 Click on **our hotel**: is there a television in every room?
 - 2 What time is breakfast served during the week?
 - 3 What type of internet connection is available in the rooms?
 - 4 Is it a non smoking hotel?
 - 5 Click on **rates and online reservations**: what is the price of a single room?
 - 6 What is the price of a double room, with single occupancy and with two people staying?
 - 7 Is there a minimum stay requirement at the weekends?

- 2 Now go back to www.newsteinehotels.com and click on the website link of the **Ascot House Hotel** on the right side of the homepage, and answer the following questions:
 - 1 Click on **rates**: what is the difference in price between a single and a single en suite?
 - 2 How much is a twin room?
 - 3 How much is a balcony room?
 - 4 Is breakfast included in the price?
 - 5 Are toiletries provided in each room?
 - 6 Click on **breakfast**: what do the hotel hosts Jackie and Rob do every Sunday?
 - 7 Read Ascot's menu and decide what you would like to eat for breakfast.

TEACHER'S NOTES:

The best hotel...

Aim: to use the internet to look for hotel information - comparing information about two hotels in Brighton. This worksheet is designed to be used in conjunction with unit 10.

Time: 40 minutes

Materials: photocopies of the worksheet for each student.

- 1 Make sure all students are on the correct website. Ask students if any of them have visited Brighton and stayed in a hotel there. Then direct students to answer the questions. Monitor, and help where necessary, to check that student are finding the right information. Elicit answers.

Answers: [Correct at the time of going to press] 1 yes 2 7:30am - 9am 3 wireless 4 yes 5 (July 05) prices from £25 per night 6 £40 and £80 (July 05) 7 2 nights at weekends and 3 nights on public holiday weekends

- 2 Students answer the questions. Elicit the answers from the class.

Answers: [Correct at the time of going to press] 1 (July 05) £6 2 £70 3 £100 4 yes 5 yes 6 They provide afternoon tea for all the guests 7 lots of choice - see what students choose.

- 3 Monitor students' conversations and note down which hotel everyone has chosen. Report back to the class - which hotel has the best vote?
