 - 3 Click on the **sustainable tourism** link at the top of the page and then click **environmental policy**. Answer questions a-d.
 - a What are guests currently able to recycle?
 - b What helps to heat the swimming pools?
 - c What is being used less in the restaurants?
 - d How does the hotel ask guests to help Bedruthan be an environmentally friendly hotel?
 - 4 Scroll to the top of the page and click on **tariff and bookings** and then **tariff**, and complete the following information for a-c.
 - a Hotel price per person per night in the low season for 1-3 nights.

TEACHER'S NOTES:

Aim: to use the internet to find out information about a hotel in the UK and to consolidate the topic of holidays. This webquest is designed to be used in conjunction with unit 6.

Time: 40 minutes

Materials: photocopies of the worksheet for each student

- 1 Make sure all students are on the correct website. Ask them if any of them have stayed at a hotel in the UK. Get students to work through all the questions. Monitor as they work to find they are finding the correct part of the website and can understand enough language to answer the questions. Elicit answers from the class at the end of the activity.

Answers: (correct at the time of going to press) 1 The hotel's attitude was found to be exemplary. 2 a) wild and spectacular b) North Cornish Coast c) information about offers and events 3 a) paper, magazines, cans and bottles b) solar panels c) individually packaged foods such as jams and sugars d) don't leave taps running after brushing teeth, switch lights out when leaving the room and give the hotel more ideas on re-using and recycling. 4 a) £75 b) £105 c) £12

- 2 Students have more freedom here to scroll through the list of attractions in Cornwall. Ask students to work with a partner to decide on five places of interest. Monitor to check that students understand what they need to. Ask students to present their five top places to visit to the rest of the class and get feedback.
