TEACHER'S NOTES:

Aim: to use the Internet to explore the theme of 'In town'. This webquest is designed to be used in conjunction with unit 4.

Time: 40 minutes

Materials: copy of the worksheet for each student

- 1 Make sure that all students have reached the correct website. Students can work together or on their own. Students navigate around the map to check whether the sentences are true or false. Make sure that all students have the bigger version of the map as this is easier to work with. Elicit answers from the class.

- 2 Students work in pairs and ask each other questions about the map using the language structure provided (and also used in communication for unit 4). Monitor to check that they are using the language correctly.
- 3 Students write the answers to the questions they asked about the location of various places in Cambridge. Ask for class feedback.
