TEACHER'S NOTES:

Aim: to use the Internet to explore the theme of leisure: in this case eating and restaurants. This webquest is designed to be used in conjunction with unit 8.

Time: 40 minutes

Materials: copy of the worksheet for each student

- 1 Ask students if anyone has ever visited Edinburgh. Make sure that they can all find the website. Students can work in pairs or alone to answer the questions. The very top of the page has all the headings very clearly marked that they need to click on to find the answers. Monitor to check that all students are clicking in and out of the headings with ease. Elicit answers from the class.

Answers (correct at time of going to press): a) Situated in Leith (Edinburgh's waterfront), north of Edinburgh City Centre; b) Seven days a week for lunch and dinner; c) £7.45; d) Yes; e) From the Alsace region in France; f) Denis Guilloneau

- 2 Make sure that all students select a favourite and tell their partner about it. Ask for class feedback.
- 3 Students click on the 'Table d'Hote' part of the menu and find all the prices listed. Elicit answers from the class.

Answers (correct at time of going to press):

Bottle of wine = £12.00

Daniel's special hot chocolate = £2.75

Cappuccino or latte = £1.95

Espresso = £1.45

Pot of tea = £1.95

3 course Table d'Hote + 1 glass of wine = £20

- 4 Students decide what they would like for starter, main course and dessert from the Table d'Hote menu. Encourage them to look at the other sample menus if they prefer. Ask for class feedback.
