

## Colourful World Lesson Plan

**Learning objectives:** Understanding and saying the key colours

**Skill/Grammar:** Listening and speaking

**Preparation Time:** 15 minutes

**Completion Time:** 45–60 minutes

**Age/Level:** 6–8/Beginners

**Resources:** Colourful World Warm-Up, Flashcards, Worksheet, Filler

### Warm-Up

- Briefly elicit known colours and introduce new ones using the ideas in the warm-up activity (**Colourful World Warm-Up**).
- Review numbers 1 to 10 by writing numbers at random on the board. Point at them and ask students to say what they are.

### Presentation

- Consolidate the colours further with the flashcards (**Colourful World Flashcards**).
- Once students are confident about the colours, tell them (in L1) they are going to do some simple maths to work out the colours of some balloons. Give out copies of **Colourful World Worksheet** and do the colours orally. Consolidate individually by having students colour in the balloons.

#### Answer Key:

- 1 + 2 = green
- 9 - 8 = brown
- 10 - 8 = red
- 4 + 5 = blue
- 2 + 10 = orange
- 8 - 1 = pink
- 9 - 3 = yellow
- 2 + 3 = grey
- 6 + 2 = white
- 8 - 4 = black

## Colourful World Lesson Plan

### Practice

- Ask students to guess the names of the animals in the **Colourful World Filler**. Then get students to complete the colours orally. This activity could then be done in writing for homework, if appropriate.

#### Answer Key:

- 1      **white, black**
- 2      **yellow, black**
- 3      **black**
- 4      **grey**
- 5      **green**
- 6      **red, green, blue**
- 7      **pink**
- 8      **white**

- For further consolidation of the colours have students do the **Colourful world Crossword**.
- For differentiation you might ask weaker students to play the domino game. Demonstrate how it works before asking them to work with a partner (**Colourful world – Domino Game**).

### Closure

- Review the colour vocabulary with a guessing game with the flashcards. Hide each colour and ask students to guess what it is. Give the flashcards to students who guess correctly (**Colourful World Flashcards**).
- For homework students could prepare their own balloon picture with sums in the balloons to test their partners. They could also produce a different key.
